

**CHAPTER II**

**THE RESULTS OF NKR 2015 POPULATION CENSUS AND  
HOUSING CONDITIONS**

## PART 1. POPULATION ACCORDING TO THE ADMINISTRATIVE- TERRITORIAL DISTRIBUTION

---

### Methodological Clarifications

Two categories of population, de facto and de jure population are calculated by the NKR Population Census results.

**De facto population** number of each administrative unit during NKR 2015 Population Census was formed by summarizing the total numbers of persons enumerated therein as permanently (usually) resident and present at the time of Census *and temporarily present* (at the time of Census).

The number of Temporarily present population includes those persons who at the Census time for less than one year have been in the current community: town, village, house (building) or organization as a temporary dwelling, and their permanent residence was out of the community (including republic) borders.

**De jure population** number of each administrative unit was formed by total number sum of therein permanently (usually) living and at the enumeration moment present *and temporarily absent* enumerated persons.

Temporarily absent population number was included those absent persons number who permanently (usually) lived in the current community: town, village, house (building) but at the enumeration moment for less than one year have been out of the urban or rural community (including republic) borders.
